- 3) Give a brief history of your Christian journey and explain how your faith informs and shapes your personal life and professional goals.

Short Answer Questions

On a separate sheet of paper, please provide the following information.

- 1) What strengths, skills or experience do you possess that you feel would make you a good fit for this role?
- 2) If you plan to pursue additional education in the future, describe the kind of study you would like to undertake, including the degree(s), the subject matter, and when you intend to apply.
- 3) Have you been involved with a ministry of the Foundation? If so, explain how your involvement with a ministry of the Foundation has shaped your own personal and spiritual growth. If not, explain how another ministry has shaped your own personal and spiritual growth.
- 4) Describe your extracurricular involvement in activities, organizations, and programs (i.e., student government, campus newspaper, sports, academic fraternity, residential study programs, volunteering, etc.).
- 5) Describe, in priority order, the positions of leadership and responsibility which you have held. What would those who have worked with or under you list as your strengths and weaknesses?
- 6) Describe any distinguished honors, awards, achievements, and special recognitions.
- 7) Briefly describe how you found out about the Laity Fellowship Program.
