

## Want to be a Camp Nurse at LLYC?

Laity Lodge Youth Camp hires two Registered Nurses per campsite each week who are responsible for providing care to the campers and staff of the campsite.

## **POSITION SPECIFICS**

- **Team:** Two RNs, Healthcare Assistants, and shared practitioner (MD or APRN)
- Manage camper check-in, administer medications, provide first aid and care per standing orders, and be prepared to respond to emergencies.
- Both RNs assist with camper check-in on arrival—Sundays 1 p.m. to 12 a.m.
- The remainder of the week, work is organized by shifts.
  - Day Shift: 8:00 a.m. 4:00 p.m.
  - Night Shift: 4:00 p.m. 12:00 a.m.
  - On-Call Alternating Nights
- Collaborate with the on-site camp practitioner, directors, and parents to ensure health and safety.
- Communicate and collaborate with parents and team.
- Document all care provided via computer charting.
- Monitor for and intervene in community health concerns.
- Wear a radio at all times and respond to emergencies.

## **REQUIREMENTS**

- Current Texas RN License
- Love for children and the outdoors
- Ability to practice with autonomy while knowing when to consult the practitioner and/or Director of Health Services
- Ability to be flexible to cover the camp health needs
- Emergency, pediatric, or school nursing experience preferred

- One-week commitment (Sunday-Saturday or Saturday-Saturday)
- Nurse in an autonomous way that teaches campers/staff self-management and fosters health and independence while trying something new
- Immediate family welcome to come with RN and enjoy camp amenities
- Private housing and all meals provided
- Time off to enjoy camp
- Can participate in camp activities as clinic volume allows
- Experience the joy of caring for kids and adults in nature
