

PONDER

CHOOSE

- a few people
- a verse or verses to talk about together
- a word that pops out of a verse as you read
- a word from a song, a book, a study, a podcast

PEN & PAPER

write one word. STOP.
 one phrase. STOP.
 leave **space** - take time - see how the words connect
 circle the words that stand out to you
underline. draw arrows. scribble.
 write down anything that comes to mind

DIG & DISCUSS

look at the word. **picture** it.
 what comes to mind when you think about this word?
define it. compare to other versions of the Bible
 where else do you see it in Scripture?
 BUILD PICTURES around the word with the other verses.
 what does it mean in Hebrew & Greek?
discuss. TALK about this word with someone.

LOOK & LISTEN

ask the SPIRIT to **make you aware**
 remain *in* your word
 even when your Bible & journal are closed
 through creation, music, art, images, conversation...
 what is He revealing?
 "GOD give me **eyes to see & ears to hear**"

PONDER & PRAY

keep pondering. remaining. abiding.
SPEAK. SING. PRAY.
 an ongoing conversation with God & others
 pray words for your friends & family - your situation
 give words time & **space**
 the SPIRIT speaks & the WORD will keep moving!
